**Education:**

Patrick attended Franklin High School in Seattle, Washington, and graduated in 1959. Mr. Patrick joined the military after high school and received honorable discharge in 1963. Today he continues to be an active participant in the local Seattle community and corporate structures.

**Business Background:**

Patrick became the Executive Vice President & Member of Board of Directors of United Bank in 1980, a Savings Bank in Tacoma, Washington. In 1983 he took position as President & CEO, Member of Board of Directors, NASDAQ Prudential Bancorporation, Seattle, Washington. Later merging into Pacific First Federal Bancorp. In 1985 Patrick became the President & CEO Mariner Federal Savings & Loan Association, and merged with Prudential Bancorp.
