

In 1970 a group of friends from the University of Washington decided to hold their own running event. That first ever Seattle Marathon event was comprised of 38 runners, with 31 of them completing the full 26.2 miles. 40 years later the Seattle Marathon is still running strong and carrying on the tradition of providing a quality running event for the Seattle community.



The Amica Insurance Seattle Marathon, Marathon Walk, Half Marathon and Half Marathon Walk will take place Sunday, November 28. Early bird registration will end Sunday, May 31. The Seattle Marathon 5k Race: presented by Road Runner Sports will take place Saturday, November 27 at 8:30am followed by the Seattle Children's Kids Marathon at 10:00am.

All events will start and end at the historic Seattle Center downtown Seattle and will traverse the streets of the Emerald City.
